NATURE TRAILS

COPELAND FOREST

The Copeland Forest is filled with endless single track and is located only a few pedal strokes from the resort. Enjoy over 70km of trails through the Copeland Forest, some of which are part of the Ganaraska Trail! You can also hike through the tree-covered paths at your own pace. Access the trails through the tunnel under Horseshoe Valley Road, located at the North West corner of our main activity parking lot. Use Trailforks QR code to help find your way.
